MAINTENANCE

YOUR THERMOSTAT: Generally, an air conditioning system is designed to handle up to a 20-degree difference between the outside and inside temperatures while maintaining a comfortable 50% humidity level. For example, if it's 80 degrees outside, your AC can easily cool the inside to 70 degrees, as that's only a 10-degree difference. However, if it's 100 degrees outside, achieving 70 degrees indoors would strain the system, potentially leading to excess humidity and other issues. To avoid this, keep your AC settings on AUTO and set to Cool or Heat.
